#### 1 EVENTS

The Denver Sailing Association (DSA) as the organizing authority will conduct the Rocky Mountain Shootout Regatta at Cherry Creek Reservoir, Aurora, CO, Saturday, May 16<sup>th</sup> and Sunday, May 17<sup>th</sup>, 2015.

#### 2 RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined by the 2013-2016 *Racing Rules of Sailing* except as changed by this NOR, the Regatta Sailing Instructions and the rules of the Colorado Parks & Wildlife and Cherry Creek State Park.

#### 3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to self righting boats. One design Keelboat fleets with five (5) or more entries will be recognized as a class. Anticipated classes are J24, U20, Santana 20, J22, and at least one PHRF class. Additional classes may be established at the discretion of the Race Committee. Classes may be formed into divisions for starting purposes & courses.
- 3.2 To enter, complete and sign the enclosed form, pay the entry fee in <u>Section 4 Fees</u>, and mail the form and entry fee to the regatta chair listed below or register online at <u>www.denversailing.org</u>. Entry may also be completed at the time of registration.

#### 4 FEES

Rocky Mountain Shootout fees are \$75 for DSA members and \$85 for others paid by May 8<sup>th</sup> 2015 and \$95 for DSA members and \$105 for others received or postmarked after May 8<sup>th</sup>, 2014, Juniors (18 and under) are \$25 with no late fee. Early registration may be completed by mail or electronically at <a href="https://www.denversailing.org">www.denversailing.org</a>.

## 5 SCHEDULES

Saturday, May 16<sup>th</sup>, 2014: On Site Registration 0900-1100 Competitor's meeting 1100 First warning signal 1200, subsequent signals & races to follow

Sunday, May 17<sup>th</sup>, 2014: First warning signal 1100, subsequent signals & races to follow No race warning after 1500

On Site registration will be available at the Denver Sailing Association Clubhouse. Sailing Instructions will be distributed to competitors at Registration and may be posted at <a href="www.denversailing.org">www.denversailing.org</a>. Up to eight (8) races are scheduled. One race completed will constitute a regatta. Competitors who registered by mail on online at <a href="www.denversailing.org">www.denversailing.org</a> are required to check-in at the On Site registration desk to pick up their Sailing Instructions.

#### **6 NOTICES TO COMPETITORS**

Notices to competitors will be posted on the official DSA notice board located on the Denver Sailing Association Club House.

#### 7 CHANGES TO THE RULES

The Sailing Instructions may modify the rules. Anticipated changes include but are not limited to: modification of Appendix A Low Point Score System as described in Section 10: Scoring, and Rule 26 to allow Race Committee discretion to use the Sound Signal Starting System referenced in Appendix S.

#### 8 PRIZES

Trophies will be awarded based on the number of competitors in each class. The perpetual trophy will be awarded to the boat scoring best among all fleets; scoring for this trophy will be described in the sailing instructions.

#### 9 VENUE

All races will be held on Cherry Creek Reservoir.

#### 10 SCORING

- 10.1 The Low Point Scoring System in Appendix A will be used with the modifications stated in this Notice of Race:
- 10.2 Appendix A 4.2 is modified as follows: DNF = number of finishers plus 1 DNS, OCS = number of starters plus 1 DNC = number of competitors plus 1 DSQ = total number of boats sailing at least one race in the series plus 2 RET (Retired) = number of finishers plus 1 RAF (Retired After Finishing) = number of finishers plus 1
- 10.3 The race committee will assign handicaps for boats entering the handicap (PHRF) class without SAIL PHRF certificates. Handicap appeals shall be addressed only to the SAIL PHRF Committee by SAIL PHRF members.

#### 11 RADIO COMMUNICATION

The Race Committee reserves the right to make announcements on the water via VHF radio on channel 69 in addition to announcements made under Code L. These may include OCS calls and advanced warning of upcoming starting sequences and schedules.

#### 12 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4 Decision to Race. Denver Sailing Association as the organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
