1 EVENTS

The Denver Sailing Association (DSA) will conduct the Colorado Governor's Cup Regatta at Cherry Creek Reservoir, Aurora, CO. Saturday, September 19 and Sunday, September 20, 2015. DSA is the organizing authority

2 RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined by the 2013-2016 *Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS) except as changed by this NOR, the Sailing Instructions, the rules of the Colorado Division of Parks & Wildlife, and Cherry Creek State Park.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all PHRF and Portsmouth rated boats. One design fleets with four (4) or more entries will be recognized as a class. Anticipated classes are J24, J22, U20, Santana 20, Lightning, Laser, and at least one PHRF and one Portsmouth Handicap class. Additional classes may be established at the discretion of the Race Committee. Classes may be formed into divisions for starting purposes & courses.
- **3.2** To enter, complete and sign the <u>entry form</u>, pay the entry fee in **Section 4 Fees**, and mail the form and entry fee to the address listed on the bottom of the form **or register online at <u>www.denversailing.org</u>**. Entry may be completed at the time of registration.

4 FEES

Fees are \$95 (\$75 for dinghy and catamaran) for members of DSA and \$105 (\$85 for dinghy and catamaran) for others prior to September 11, 2015. A late fee of \$20 will be added to registrations postmarked/recorded after September 11, 2015. Juniors (18 and under) are \$25 with no late fee. Members of S.A.I.L. will receive a \$10 discount.

On Site registration will be outside the DSA club house at Cherry Creek Marina. Sailing Instructions will be distributed to competitors at Registration and may be posted at www.denversailing.org. Up to eight (8) races are scheduled. One race completed will constitute a regatta. All competitors are required to check-in at the On Site registration desk to pick up their Sailing Instructions and sign their waivers.

6 NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

Notices to competitors will be posted on the official DSA notice board on the DSA club house.

7 CHANGES TO THE RULES

The Sailing Instructions may modify the rules. Anticipated changes include but are not limited to: modification of Appendix A Low Point Score System as described in 10 Scoring, SI Changes on the Water and Protest Arbitration

8 PRIZES

8.1

Trophies will be awarded based on the number of competitors in each class. The perpetual trophy will be awarded to the boat scoring best among all fleets; scoring for this trophy will be described in the sailing instructions.

8.2 The Colorado Governor's Cup Dinghy Perpetual Trophy will be awarded to the winner of the dinghy division as described in the Deed of Gift.

9 VENUE

All races will be held on Cherry Creek Reservoir.

10 SCORING

- 10.1 The Low Point Scoring System in Appendix A will used with the modifications stated in this Notice of Race:
- **10.2** Appendix A is modified so that after 5 races are completed, each boat's single worst score will be thrown out.
- **10.3** Appendix A 4.2 is modified as follows:

DNF = number of finishers plus 1

DNS, OCS, DNC = number of starters plus 1

DSQ = number of competitors plus 2
